

Costessey Centre handed over to Parish Council on 16th April 2010



After more than 30 years of planning, two previous abortive attempts and numerous disappointments, Costessey finally has its own Community Centre - a building to shout about, one that makes a statement that Costessey is a vibrant community looking to the future. Standing on the site of the old asbestos-clad pavilion, the Costessey Centre proudly catches the eye for those venturing along Longwater Lane or using the Recreation Ground. Designed by architects Vincent & Gorbing and constructed by contractors Morgan Ashurst, the Centre was completed just one week late despite the appalling winter weather.
