

## **NOTES from the ON-LINE Local Infrastructure Review Working Group held on Thursday 21 January 2021 at 11am**

**Present:** Cllrs T East (Chair), J Amis, G Blundell, D Burrill, G Jones, T Laidlaw, J Newby, P O'Connor; H Elias (Clerk), N Bailey (Deputy Clerk)

1 The meeting had been called to suggest and discuss various projects for the future, both major external projects for negotiation with other bodies, so that Costessey TC could "set part of the wider agenda", and a four-year project plan for Costessey TC (2019-2023).

2 Various suggestions were made incorporating land within the Costessey area that was not owned by Costessey TC. The Greater Norwich Local Plan (GNLP) Policy and sites were discussed. The population of Costessey had been quoted by SNC as 25,000 and the level of investment by the District Council into Costessey had been raised.

3 New multi-purpose facilities with parking, which would then attract other supporting business and services, and an upgrade of transport infrastructure were suggested. Councillors to make enquiries / research and the Clerk to contact SNC Head of Planning.  
**ACTION: Town Clerk**

4 Various projects were under way and others suggested. Additional members of staff were mooted. Funding should be sought. Deputy Clerk to collate current and possible future projects for easy reference and approval by Cllrs. **ACTION: Deputy Clerk**

5 A "Projects Board" could be formed with officers reporting to the Board two weeks before the full Council meetings, with a timeline and MS Teams used to allow access to documents by Cllrs.

6 A strategic view of the halls should be considered by a WG.

7 The next WG meeting could be in May or on 4 March at 10.30am if enough information was received for consideration.
