Road Closure on Breckland Road, Costessey (B198/22) - pavement maintenance

Essential work will begin on Monday, 27 July 2020 to carry out pavement maintenance works on Breckland Road in Costessey. The work will take approximately six weeks to complete subject to weather conditions.

To carry out the work safely it will be necessary to close Breckland Road to all through traffic and a signed diversion route will be in place. Access to properties within the closure will be maintained.

Due to the nature of the work there will be times when sections of the road and pavement, including vehicular accesses to properties, will be temporarily unavailable. During these times residents are asked to park their vehicles at alternative locations. Anyone who has any specific access requirements can contact us using the email address below, or speak to the team on site, so these can be accommodated wherever possible.

Work has been programmed to take place during school holidays to minimise disruption. Locations of the phased road closures can be found within this letter. The County Council thanks people for their patience while this pavement improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost approximately £58,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
